Hurricane Michael

- Special Thanks
- Impacted FSU Tallahassee students
 - Increase in students accessing UCC by 19% post storm
 - Distributed a month's worth of supplies from the Food for Thought pantry in 2 days
 - 10 students identified as needing new housing as a result of storm damage re-housed through Dean of Students
- Impacted FSU Panama City students
 - 31 Pathway students moved to Tallahassee campus and completed orientation
 - 150 students completed a needs survey to better determine needs and plans for the academic year
 - Created a case management hotline staffed at FSU Tallahassee



Hurricane Michael

- Case Management
 - 248 student contacts over the two week period of storm
 - Over 38% increase in students seeking assistance compared to these weeks last year
 - At least 37 students identified as needing assistance due to the storm
 - In general, 16% increase in new student cases from last academic year, and 19% increase in overall contacts with students




Student Affairs Strategic Goals
