- University Health Services will be taking over the COVID-19 vaccination program (large vaccine events will remain a University-wide collaboration)




Diversity and Inclusion Efforts

- Hiring a Director, Student Life in partnership with Dean Hanna to continue to support Panama City students.




Union Art: The Seminole Tribe of Florida
