Conducted Current State Assessment & Inventory

Work Completed

- Established committees with cross-campus representation to define the vision for FSU Health
- Conducted interviews with FSU faculty and leaders

Outcomes

- Created an inventory of 100+ current state health-related programs across the university
- Synthesized interview findings and data analytics to inform future planning

Formulated Initial FSU Health Programming

Work Completed

- Identified opportunities for FSU Health to expand existing programs and develop new initiatives
- Developed a prioritization framework
- Began development of internal and external communication plans

Outcomes

- Created an initial portfolio of programmatic themes (research, education, clinical) for FSU Health

- Conducted a systematic review of FSU Health opportunities
- Held a working session with key FSU Health leaders
- Reviewed potential partnership opportunities
