

RECORD GRADUATION RATES

Highest in FSU history and among the top 10 nationally



ADVANCING STUDENT SUCCESS



- Hosted Nobel Laureate Carl Wieman, a renowned physicist and educator
 - How research-based approaches to teaching (e.g., active learning) can support student learning
- Many faculty already engaged in this approach, often with our new Center for the Advancement of Teaching
 - Seeing improved student performance with our Learning Assistants (LA) pilot
- Provost's Teaching Awards

ADVANCING STUDENT SUCCESS

- 1. Addressing course bottlenecks to improve student progression
- 2. Using standard meeting times so students can build schedules
- 3. Reducing class sizes to enrich the learning environment
- 4. Create Engage 100-funded 1st year learning communities
- 5. Redesigning courses and reducing disparities in DFW rates

- New funding metric: entrepreneurship and innovation courses
- Likely new funding metrics: grad rates for transfer & Pell students

INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION



- FSU presented the top national award in international education and engagement by APLU (Platinum Award in Global Learning, Research, and Engagement)
- FSU was also ranked #1 in Florida for study abroad and in the top 10 nationally among publics

PROGRAM EXCELLENCE


- Jim Moran School of Entrepreneurship received a top award from the U.S. Association for Small Business and Entrepreneurship

- · Rankings improvement in social work, public affairs, and education




UNDERGRADUATE APPLICATIONS

Another record of nearly 60,000 applications (up ~17% over last year)


