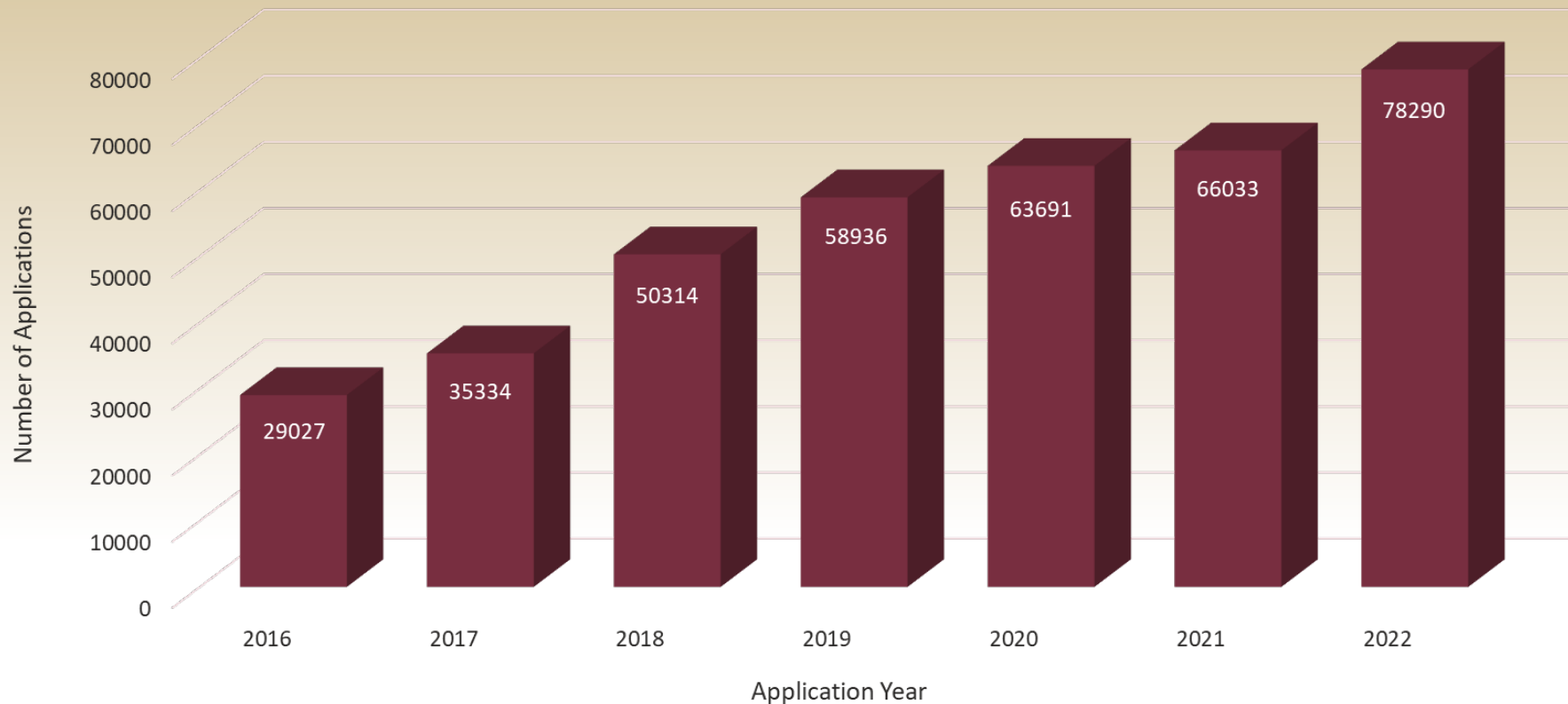

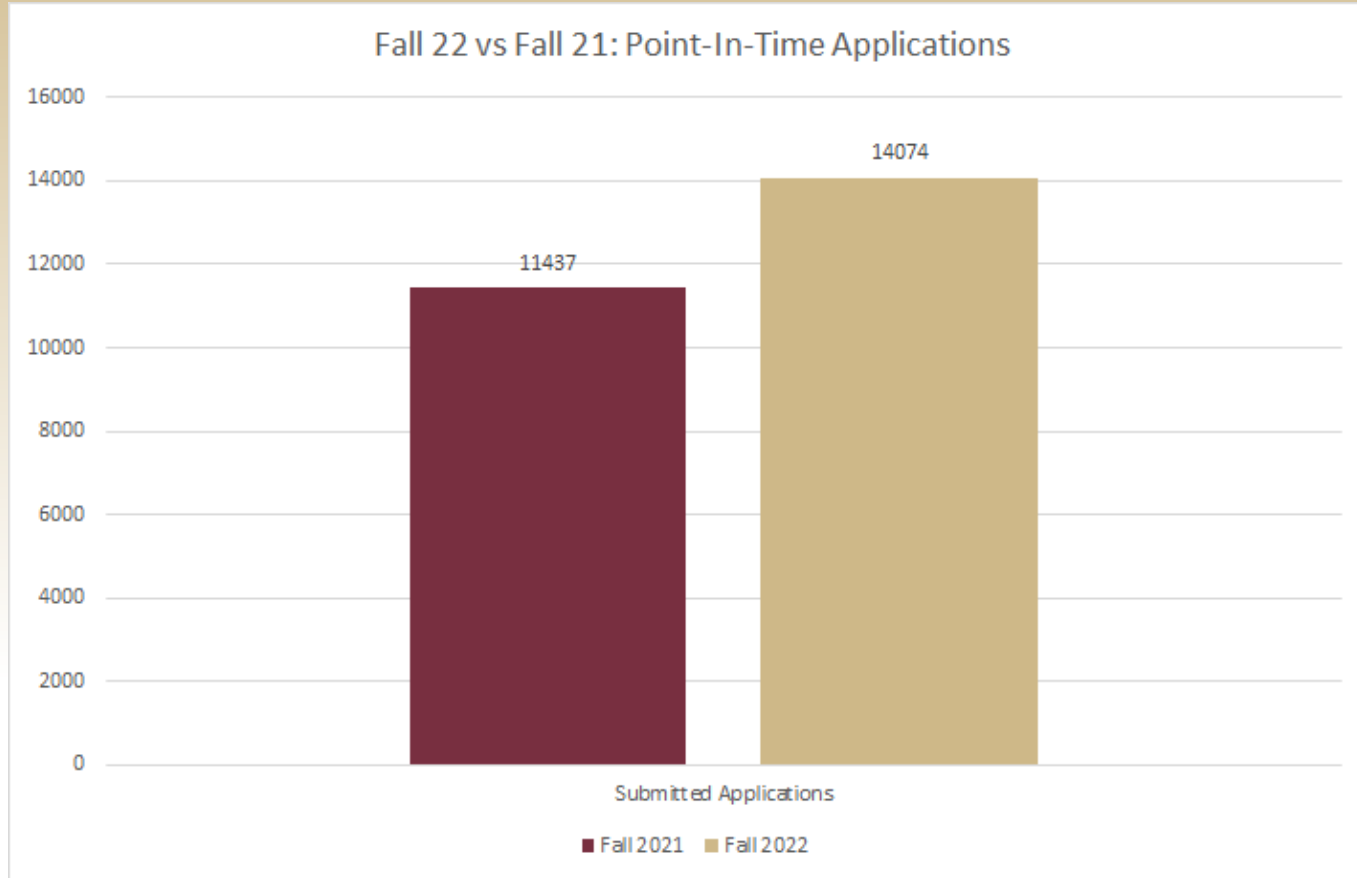

# FSU'S LEARNING SYSTEMS INSTITUTE



Since start of 2022, FSU's LSI already has over \$27M in new grants, including:

- \$15.6M to strengthen teacher education & practice in Malawi
- \$4M to train 20K Florida teachers in civics education
- \$1.5M to support Career and Technical Education teachers
- \$4.5M to support the implementation of new civics and government standards in K-12
- \$1.3M to create math tests for the new PreK-Grade 2 Florida progress monitoring system



# FLORIDA CENTER FOR READING RESEARCH



- FSU's FCRR secured the Regional Educational Laboratory award for the Southeast U.S. from the U.S. Department of Education
- \$27M over five years
- Improve outcomes for students in the Southeast—from early childhood to adulthood—through research and evidence-based practices







# DANFOSS TURBOCOR PARTNERSHIP

- 5-Year, \$750K collaboration with Danfoss Turbocor and FAMU-FSU College of Engineering
- New research and student scholarship opportunities
